What do I have to do to participate in commencement?

- 1) Complete your GED® prior to June 11, 2016. Commencement is open to anyone who has passed the GED® tests after taking preparation classes through Lane's Adult Basic & Secondary Education Department.
- 2) Complete the application below. If you wish to have your name appear in the commencement program you must submit your application to the ABSE office at the Main Campus or the Downtown Campus by May 20, 2016.
- **Obtain your cap and gown.** Cap, gown, and tassel are <u>required</u> to participate in the commencement ceremony. Cap, gown, and tassel will be available for purchase at the Main Campus Titan store only. Important information and your name card will be included with your cap and gown. *Caps and gowns will NOT be sold at the Events Center nor at the Downtown Campus Titan store.*
- **Attend commencement on Saturday, June 11, 2016.** Participants must arrive no later than 2:00 p.m. Doors will open to guests and the public at 2:30 p.m. *You must wear your cap and gown and bring your name card to commencement.*
