HO 114 Medical Coding Procedures - change name to

HO 114 Introduction to Coding

This name change will more accurately reflect the level of work covered in the course, and will also clearly make a distinction between it and the HIM 200 level Coding classes.

HO 195 Medical Transcription 1 - change course number to

HIT 195 Medical Transcription 1

The transcription classes are HIT classes, and the three courses are a series, so for clarity, and how they display in the catalog and other documents sorted alphabetically, there should be standardization in their course numbers. The other two Medical Transcription classes are HIT 196, and HIT 197

HIT 154 Introduction to Medical Science - Name change to

HIT 154 Introduction to Disease Processes

This name change will more accurately reflect the content covered in the course rather than the ambiguous description of "medical science", which is too broad for a single class.
