Board Member Attributes

1. Abiding by and helping to reshape the Board's current Mission, Goals and Objectives.
2. Demonstrable institutional support (release time, staff seconding and/or budgetary support) to serve as a Board member.
3. Ability to advocate for the various affinity groups from the constituency that the candidate is representing.
4. Ability to represent the candidate's sponsoring institution.
5. Candidate that expands the Board's current representation (e.g. four year college and/or university, K-12, non-profit social service organizations, other public sector organizations, regional representation, and grass roots organizations, and members of the private sector.
6. Two years service commitment.
7. Ability to attending not less than 75% of board meetings, committee meetings and special events.
8. Willingness to learn and understand diverse perspectives and explore issues of access, social justice, human rights, and equity.
