## Financial Aid Eligible Programs

To qualify for financial aid, you must enroll in one of Lane's Financial Aid eligible programs with the intent of completing the program. Not all programs offered at Lane are eligible for financial aid funding.

### Eligible Programs

- **All Associate degree programs, except the following Apprenticeship programs:**
  - Construction Trades, General Apprenticeship
  - Electrician Apprenticeship Technologies
  - Industrial Mechanics and Maintenance Technology Apprenticeship
- **All One-Year and Two-Year Certificate programs, except:**
  - Construction Trades, General Apprenticeship
  - Electrician Apprenticeship Technologies
  - Limited Electrician Apprenticeship Technologies
  - Industrial Mechanics and Maintenance Technology Apprenticeship
  - Occupational Skills Training
  - Web Design

### Limited Eligibility Programs

While completing prerequisites for a program that has a competitive/point based admissions process, you have limited or no financial aid eligibility. Your options include: 1) complete the AGS, AAOT, or AS degree while taking your prerequisites; 2) complete your prerequisites without the benefit of financial aid; or 3) request Preparatory Funding (i.e. loans at a reduced level) for a maximum of 12 consecutive months. This option is available one time during your lifetime. Forms are available online.

### Ineligible Programs & Academic Goals

You cannot receive federal or state financial aid, including loans, if your academic goals fall under any of the categories listed below. However, you may qualify for scholarships and Private Alternative Educational loans depending on the lender you choose.

- Continuing Education programs and courses (i.e. non-credit)
- Coursework toward any program where the degree or certificate is not awarded by Lane, including:
  - Direct Transfer program
  - Collaboration Programs between Lane and other institutions
  - Pre-reqs for graduate school
- Taking EMT certification coursework (EMT 151 & EMT 152) without the intent to earn the one-year certificate
- Apprenticeship programs
- Oregon Transfer Module (this is a transcript notation only)
- Practical Nursing Bridge Coursework (completions is considered an admission requirement to the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the Associate degree, therefore you may qualify for Preparatory Loan Funding during this time)
- Career Pathway Certificate of Completion Programs\*\*

*\*\*Some Associate of Applied Science and One-Year Certificate programs fully embed within them the coursework to earn a Career Pathway Certificate (CPC). These certificates are between 12-44 credits and are not eligible for financial aid as stand alone programs; however, you may receive financial aid for the CPC coursework if you intend to complete the longer program and the longer program is eligible for financial aid. Be certain to choose your courses wisely – sometimes the CPC courses are elective choices for the longer program.*
