

Lane Alert

"Lane Alert!" is a text notifications system that allows the college to send emergency text messages to students, faculty, and staff through their registered personal cellular devices (i.e., computer, email, cell phone). For example, if LCC closes because of inclement weather, Lane Alert will notify you of this closure.

Signing up for Emergency Notifications:

Lane offers notifications to students and faculty in the event of a campus emergency and/or school closure in the following ways:

- Website announcements in the "News and Events" box on the Lane Home Page, www.lanecc.edu
- Radio announcements on KLCC, Florence station KCST (106.9 fm), and other radio stations
- Television news announcements, email and text messaging (requires signing up)

How to sign up:

To stay up-to-date with the very latest emergency notifications, you can sign up for external notifications through *myLane*. These notifications include voice messages, emails, and text messages.

Follow these steps for notifications:

- Log into *myLane*. In the "Home" tab, locate the box labeled "Personal Information."
- Select the "Lane Alert Emergency Notification" link.
- Select which notifications you would like to receive.
- Scroll down to the very bottom of the page and click "Save Changes."

When you receive a Lane Alert, be sure to **READ THROUGH ENTIRE ALERT MESSAGE FOR INFORMATION REGARDING LCC FLORENCE CENTER.** If you are unsure about the Lane Alert message, call LCC Florence Center at (541) 997-8444.
