Wetlands Update	Discussion: The grant is still under review. The plan is still to present to College Council when more is finalized.
Scenario Planning	Discussion: Most of the updates have been emailed to Facilities Council members. Briefly, there is wide
	support for the scenario planning process at Lane. Timing of when to include all or most stakeholders seems to
	be more distant than originally thought. Facilities Council will proceed with a mini scenario planning exercise to
	become more familiar with the process and reap some needed information for current work. To that end the
	Planning Task Force, a sub group of Facilities Council, will meet with their first task being an outline on learning
	how to scenario plan.

	we examine current policy, the wording and appropriateness of phrasing in current policy. It seems that
	procedures and policies have become entangled with one another. The objective is to find clarity and
	preciseness in terminology of the Campus Planning Policy in order to have the most instructive and useful aid in
