	 Faculty wants to purchase new software that is not normally provided by IT or is not currently used by another faculty member. Must go to the Math Tech Committee. Bill suggested adding a step of coming to the IT Department as there may be more information on the software that the department isn't aware of at the time. Math department doesn't want to buy software just for preferences – especially if they already have software that does the
	 same functions. Want the faculty member to learn the department preferred software What about departments that don't have Advisory Committees or Tech Committees but want to buy software? If department is not large enough for a committee, perhaps IT could provide an advisor as a consultant to answer questions.
