Bond Update	Discussion: CLASS Project is at 100% design development for the Titan Store renovation; floors 1-3 are at 50% DD. The project is on budget and on schedule. The first two Central Plant boilers are in; other two are being installed. Cooling towers will be a summer project. The chiller still needs a location. Geo-wells are being considered; planners are trying to tie projects to the Climate Action Plan.

Scenario Planning	Discussion: No new report. The phone interview and reference check will be updated on April 24. A search for grant funding is ongoing. We may need to go with a 'do it yourself' approach.
