Center for Learning and Student Success Food and Drink Policy

In an effort to make our Center for Learning and Student Success (CLASS) space an inviting and functional place for study, group activity and social activities, while maximizing the shared value of the libraries collections, equipment, and furnishings, the CLASS space has a food and drink policy. By empowering responsible user behavior and our core value of sustainability, this policy attempts to achieve a balance between our users' social needs and our need to preserve and protect our collections.

## Policy

Light, packaged snacks that are not damaging to the collections, equipment, or furnishings are permitted except in the areas specified below. No outside delivery of food is permitted in this space. Beverages must be in bottles or containers that can be re-sealed or other spill resistant containers such as travel mugs, sports bottles. Beverages in cans and open containers are not permitted except in the coffee shop seating area and concourse area.

Food or beverages of any kind are not permitted under any conditions in the following areas:

- Special Collections or the "stacks"
- Computer Workstation areas
- Printers and Photocopiers
- Media Equipment
- Other Areas posted as "NO FOOD OR DRINK"

## Guidelines

In order to protect our resources and facilities from damage, we ask that you adhere to the following guidelines:

- Please use sturdy, spill-proof and resealable containers for beverages
- Please limit your consumption of food to snacks such as, pre-cut vegetables in reusable containers, granola bars, chips, nuts, pretzels, cookies, etc.
- Foods such as stir fry, pizza, burgers, fries, sandwiches, salads, etc. (meals) should be consumed on the first floor or second floor concourse area.
- Compost, Recycle, or Landfill all food and drink-related trash before you leave
- Report any spills that may occur to Campus Food Service staff immediately

This policy will be reviewed annually to ensure that collections, equipment and furnishings are protected. Users violating this policy will be asked to remove the food and drink from the area and to move to another area.
