Agenda Items	Progress, decisions or completions
Karen Edmond's position.	Kate Barry & Helen Garret reported that a decision to post this position has been made. Its description has been changed from being a community and high school marketing to a high school marketing only. Previous coverage was too wide and not as effective with high schools. The focus of this position will be to outreach and recruit mostly high school students, and once they have made the decision to attend LCC support & assisting them navigate our process and guidelines.
