The Institutional Effectiveness Committee (IEC), part of the Institutional Effectiveness Model established January 2015, will integrate and align existing institutional planning and effectiveness efforts and use performance data to assess the extent to which the college has achieved and/or is making progress toward the achievements of our mission, core themes, and strategic directions. The committee will develop systems and formats to ensure that key information is available and easily accessible. The committee will also align its work with other planning efforts including strategic enrollment management (SEM), strategic planning, and accreditation.

The IEC is chartered by and reports to the Vice Presidents for Academic and Student Affairs and College Services. Responsibilities include:

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- Establish institutional effectiveness committee work, timelines, and projects
- Prepare and disseminate needed reports related to college effectiveness at all levels of the college's planning process
- Design and implement effective technology solutions for displaying and disseminating information in collaboration with Information Technology
- Serve as a consultant to councils, committees, and departments regarding accreditation, assessment, program review, and budgets development and resource allocation development
- Assist in the development and identification of core themes, objectives, and indicators
- Monitor progress

Committee membership may be adjusted to add expertise if needed.
