## Application for Learning Together Book Infusion Grant

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- Description: Normally, at the end of the term in WR115, I introduce students to sample WR121 readings (past inclusions have been Jonathan Swift, Walker Percy, and Paulo Freire). I see Lanier's work as being consonant with the project of such writers in terms of getting an audience to rethink something.
