


Degree Progress and Success Analysis Fall 2003 Cohort Group Comparisons


All Cohort Students



All Cohort Students:

First-time credit students with 27+ attempted credits within two years who took a math placement test and who declared a major with a specific math course required. Cohort analysis was at the completion of four years.


Group 1: Degree Ready



Group 1 Degree Ready:

Cohort students were considered degree-ready if they tested into the math requirement of their self-declared major.


Group 2: Not Degree Ready Developmental Completers



Group 2 Not Degree Ready, Developmental Completers:

Cohort students were considered not 'degree-ready, developmental completers' if they tested below the math requirement of their majors and completed the developmental math courses within four years.

Group 3: Not Degree Ready Non Developmental Completers



Group 3 Not Degree Ready, Non-Developmental Completers:

Cohort students were considered not 'degree-ready, non-developmental completers' if they tested below the math requirement of their majors and had not completed the developmental math courses within four years.
