
2010 Oregon High School Graduates Enrolled at Lane in the 2010-11 Academic Year



Analysis and Action: This report provides a count of 2010 Oregon high school graduates enrolled at Lane during the 2010-11 Academic Year, based on data matching between the Oregon Department of Education and the Oregon Community College Unified Reporting System (OCCURS).

Lane's Office of High School Connections provides a variety of programs and services for high school students. College Now enables currently enrolled high school students to earn LCC credits for approved courses taken on their home high school campuses, taught by specifically qualified high school teachers. Lane's Regional Technical Education Consortium (RTEC) program offers career/technical courses to high school students in the district who do not have those classes available at their high school. Activities to help connect high school students with Lane include: Professional Technical Careers Exploration Day, Lane Preview Night, campus tours, an annual workshop for high school counselors, visitation days for students of color and diverse populations, college fairs and career fairs. The Student Recruitment & Outreach Coordinator is active with high schools in Lane County.
