

Employee Training

What is your overall rating of the training you received from Lane with respect to the requirements of your job?

To what extent has your training from Lane added to your ability for job placement and/or advancement?

- Over 88 percent of former career technical students employed in related jobs indicated that Lane's overall training was "good" or "excellent" (Table 36).
- Nearly sixty-five percent of all career technical respondents indicated that Lane's training added more than "somewhat" to their ability for job placement or advancement (Table 37). This percentage is down from seventy-six percent in the prior 2009 study.

Interpretation/Analysis

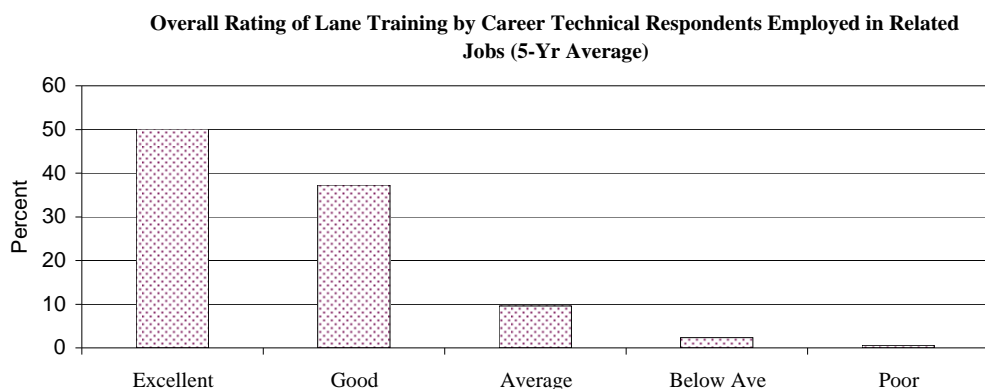
Lane continues to be a good source of training with respect to requirements on the job. A five-year average of 87.4 percent of career technical respondents employed in jobs related to their fields of study indicated their overall training from Lane was "excellent" or "good." A five-year average of 75.4 percent of all career technical respondents indicated Lane contributed more than "somewhat" to their placements or advancements.
