lines in *Eugene, Springfield, Oa-
kridge, Cottage Grove, & Creswell*.

Senior Companions receive exten-
sive training and support as well as
an hourly tax-exempt stipend of
\$2.65/hr and some reimbursement
for meals and mileage.
