

## Know Your Rights

- Right to learn and work in a safe environment. LCC follows a zero tolerance policy for all forms of sexual misconduct and gender-based discrimination.
- Right to a prompt and fair investigation.
   LCC is required to investigate all reports of sexual misconduct within 60 college work days.
- Right to file a complaint without fear of retaliation. Complainant or witnesses who report sexual misconduct are protected from retaliation under the law.
- Right to access support and health services. LCC offers confidential counseling services and can connect you with on- and off-campus resources to help you heal.
